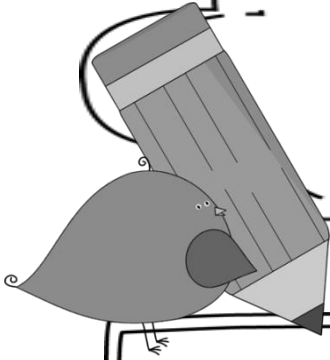

Spelling Words:

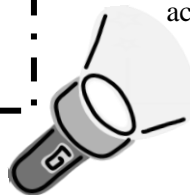
