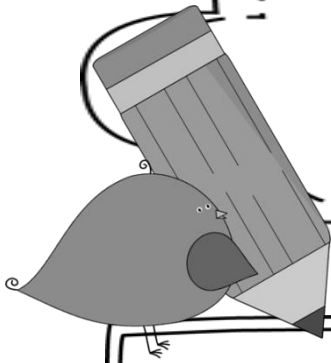

This week we will be learn to make words plural by adding -s and -es.

Spelling Words:

Pennies, inches, plants, families, bodies, glasses, wishes, pockets, lists, copies, parties, bunches, crashes, supplies, pencils, accidents, libraries, mysteries, carpenters, merchants

Vocabulary Words:

1. carpenter – someone who builds with wood
2. carpetmaker – a rug weaver
3. knowledge – having information, facts, and ideas
4. marketplace – place where people meet to buy and sell
5. merchant – someone who buys and sells goods
6. plenty - more than enough
7. straying – wandering away
8. thread – thin twisted cord
